### **Overview**

Tindle Newspapers Ltd is a family-owned, independent newspaper group. It is run by a board of directors under the chairmanship of Owen Tindle, the son of company founder Sir Ray Tindle who died in April 2022.

The day-to-day running of the company rests with chief executive Danny Cammiade and managing director Scott Wood.

The company's UK headquarters are in Farnham, Surrey, with newspaper centres in Devon, Cornwall, Somerset, East Wales, West Wales, and the Isle of Man.

The group employs around 200 people and publishes in excess of 100 paid-for newspapers and magazines.

All Tindle journalists are aware of their responsibilities and the standards expected of them. This has been reinforced through a series of mandatory online training modules undertaken by the company over the past 15 months. Journalists know to notify their Regional Digital Editor, responsible for print and digital content in each of Tindle Newspapers' seven regions, to rectify any errors.

The Regional Digital Editors can contact the Responsible Person for guidance and advice, and have done so over the past 12 months. The Responsible Person is notified when an ISPO complaint has been raised.

The IPSO complaints procedure and all relevant contact details are carried in all print publications and on every website.

### **Complaints-handling process**

The IPSO complaints procedure and all relevant contact details are carried in all print publications and on every website. This underscores how readers can raise a complaint with each newspaper or website, and explains in detail how the process works.

All complaints are dealt with at the earliest opportunity and include discussion with the complainant. Tindle Newspapers strives to resolve each and every complaint amicably.

It is the responsibility of each Regional Digital Editor to maintain a record of complaints, however minor, recording the processes, correspondence and outcomes.

The Responsible Person is notified of any complaints that have been referred to IPSO, whether they lead to a formal investigation or not. The Editorial Director is also made aware of any IPSO complaints, processes and outcomes.

The Responsible Person, along with the Regional Digital Editors, ensures that any and all ISPO complaints are dealt with in a timely, correct and responsible manner until each file is concluded satisfactorily.

Where necessary, IPSO matters are discussed with all Regional Digital Editors and the Group Editorial Direction to ensure compliance and avoidance of future occurrence of process- and editorial-based incidents.

### **Training**

All Tindle Newspapers editorial staff have been issued with copies of the Editors' Code.

All Tindle Newspapers editorial staff are told in their written job offers that the company is signed up to the IPSO Code of Practice, and that all employees are expected to follow the IPSO Code of Practice at all times.

All Tindle Newspapers' journalists are aware of their responsibilities and the standards expected of them. This has been reinforced through a series of mandatory online training modules undertaken by the company over the past 15 months.
